1 Novelties

As in the previous 2014 and 2018.1 version, this version links ethnic groups from the Ethnic Power Relations dataset directly to UCDP conflict actors (version 18.1) rather than to the Non-State Actor (NSA) database. Researchers who want to work with the NSA data can merge the two datasets through the UCDP actor ID variable.

Description: Describes whether a rebel group is supported by at least

50% of the members of an ethnic group

One ethnic group supports both the rebel group and the

government (only in non-ethnic conflicts): 2

No information: -1
